LEGAL BASIS FOR THE STATISTICAL SURVEY	Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 10 October 2019 establishing a common framework for European statistics relating to persons and households, based on data at individual level collected from samples, amending Regulations (EC) No 808/2004, (EC) No 452/2008 and (EC) No 1338/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1177/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Regulation (EC) No 577/98. Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/256 of 16 December 2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council by establishing a multiannual rolling planning. Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/2887 of 15 November 2024 specifying the technical items of the data set for the 2026 ad hoc subject on Digital Platform Employment in the labour force domain in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council.
OBJECTIVE, TYPE AND SCOPE OF THE STATISTICAL SURVEY	The purpose of the survey is to produce statistical information on the main activity on digital platforms, the nature of employment, work management and organisation, and social insurance. It is a sample statistical survey. Sample covers 2,000 persons per quarter. Statistical data are collected by interviewing the population aged 15–64.
