

INFORMATION ON THE STATISTICAL LABOUR FORCE SURVEY (STATISTICAL QUESTIONNAIRE GU-01 (QUARTERLY))

LEGAL BASIS FOR THE STATISTICAL SURVEY	Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and the Council of 10 October 2019 establishing a common framework for European statistics relating to persons and households, based on data at individual level collected samples, amending Regulations (EC) No 08/2004, (EC) No 452/200 and (EC) No 1338/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council, and repealing EC) No 1177/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Regulation No 577/98. Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/257 of 16 December 2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council by specifying the number and names of variables in the field of labour force. Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2180 of 16 December 2019 specifying detailed arrangements and content for the quality reports pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council. OBJECTIVE, TYPE AND SCOPE OF THE STATISTICAL SURVEY	The purpose of the survey is to produce and publish statistical information on the employment of the population, to assess the number of employed, unemployed and economically inactive population, their distribution by age, sex, education, etc. It is a sample statistical survey. Sample covers 8,000 households. Statistical data are collected by means of a population survey.
TIME AND PLACE OF PUBLICATION OF STATISTICAL INFORMATION	No later than 43 days after the end of the reference quarter, in the quarterly news release “Employment and Unemployment”; on the Official Statistics Portal at osp.stat.gov.lt.
OBLIGATION OF SUBMISSION OF STATISTICAL DATA	In accordance with the Law on Official Statistics and State Data Governance of the Republic of Lithuania.
