

PRIVACY NOTICE FOR STATE DATA AGENCY PORTAL NEWSLETTER SUBSCRIPTIONS

This privacy notice applies to individuals who, by subscribing, agree to receive newsletters from the State Data Agency (hereinafter – the Agency).

Who is the data controller?

The Agency is the data controller for individuals who have subscribed to the newsletter.

What personal data does the agency process?

- Contact details (email address);
- Data related to the confirmation and validity of your consent to receive the Agency’s newsletter (confirmation fact, date and time, selected subscription frequency, withdrawal of consent, date and time).

Where is personal data obtained from?

When an individual subscribes to the Agency’s newsletter.

For what purposes and on what legal basis is personal data processed?

When you subscribe to the Agency’s newsletter, your personal data will be processed for the purpose of sending newsletters. The processing is based on your consent (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR). You are not obliged to subscribe, but if you choose to do so, you must provide your personal data; otherwise, the Agency will not be able to send newsletters to you.

Who may receive personal data?

- State Digital Solutions Agency (the Agency’s data processor, which provides maintenance services for the lrv.lt portal where the Agency’s website is hosted);
- Courts, pre-trial investigation bodies, supervisory authorities, and other data controllers when required by law or when such provision is necessary and proportionate for legitimate purposes.

Are data transferred outside the EU/EEA?

The Agency does not transfer your personal data outside the EU/EEA.

How long is personal data stored?

Upon subscription, your personal data will be stored for the period of consent validity and for 2 years after the consent expires.

What technical and organizational measures are used to protect personal data?

To ensure secure exercise of data subjects’ rights, technical and organizational measures are applied, including restricted access to personal data, secure data transmission tools, internal procedures, and staff training.

What rights do you have?

Data subjects are guaranteed the following rights:

- to receive information about personal data processing;
- to access personal data;
- to request rectification of personal data;
- to request erasure of personal data (“right to be forgotten”);
- to restrict personal data processing;
- to object to personal data processing;
- to refuse or withdraw consent at any time;
- to lodge a complaint with the State Data Protection Inspectorate or the Regional Administrative Court.

Note: You may exercise the right to be forgotten or to restrict processing when at least one of the conditions listed in GDPR Article 17(1) or 18(1) applies.

You may withdraw your consent to receive newsletters by:

1. Clicking “Unsubscribe from newsletter” in the received email;
2. Contacting the Agency (requesting removal from the newsletter mailing list) using the email address you originally registered for the subscription.
