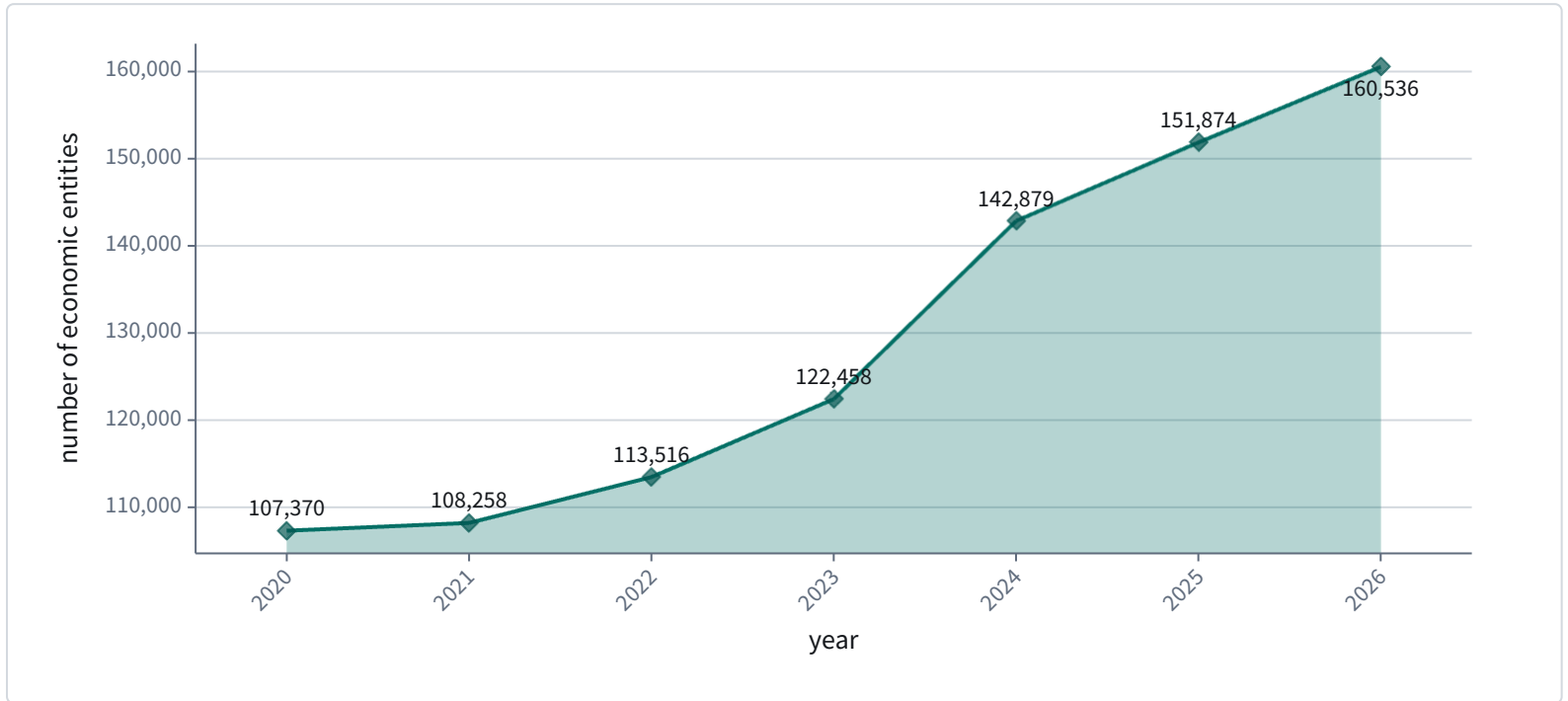
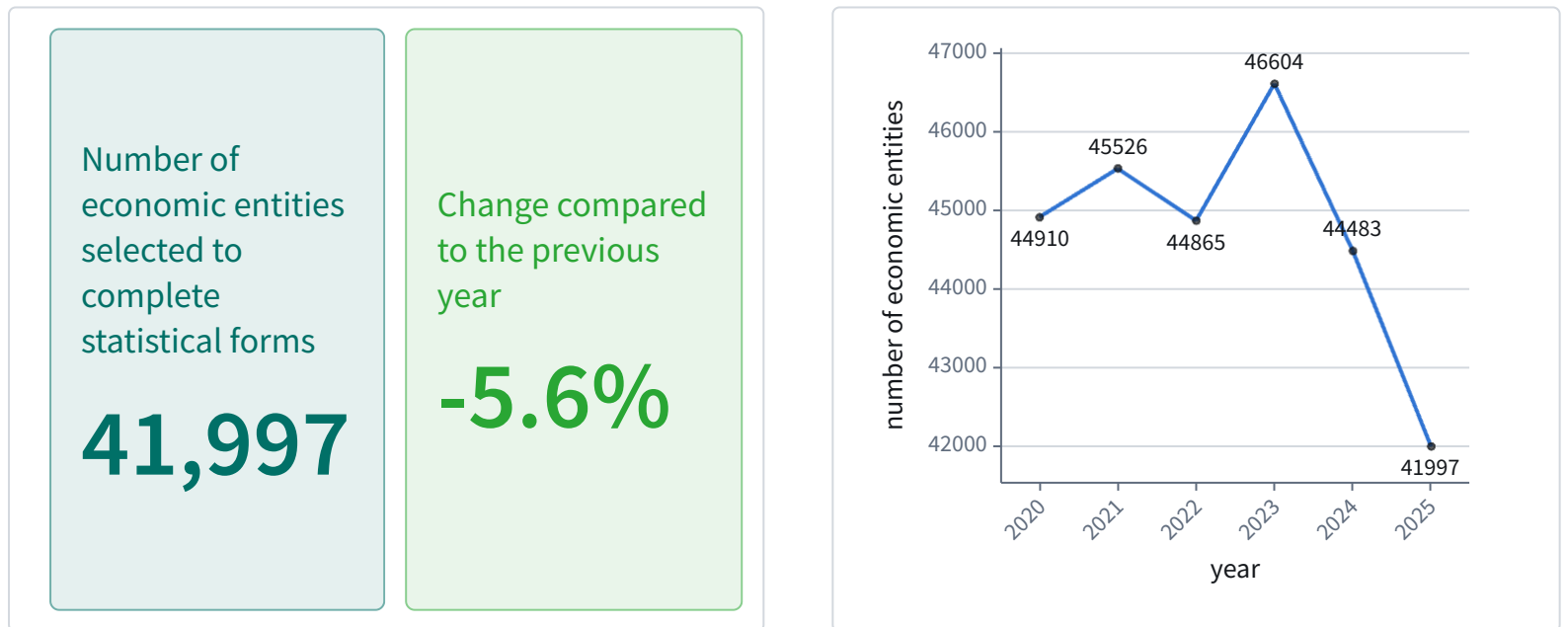

Number of active economic entities



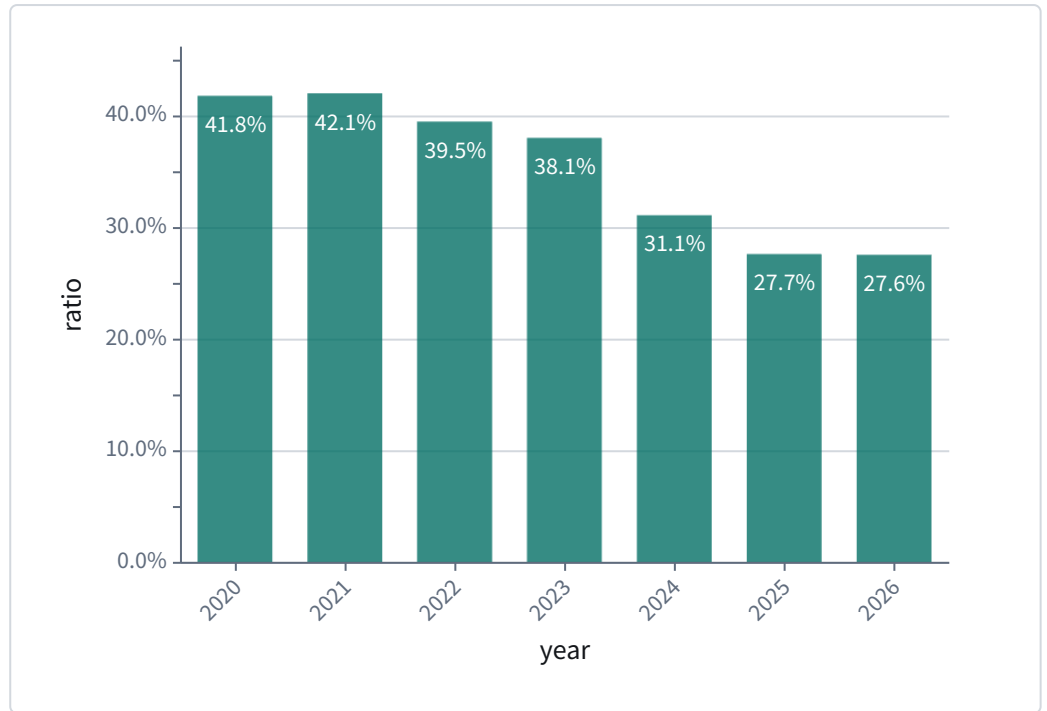
Number of economic entities selected to complete statistical forms

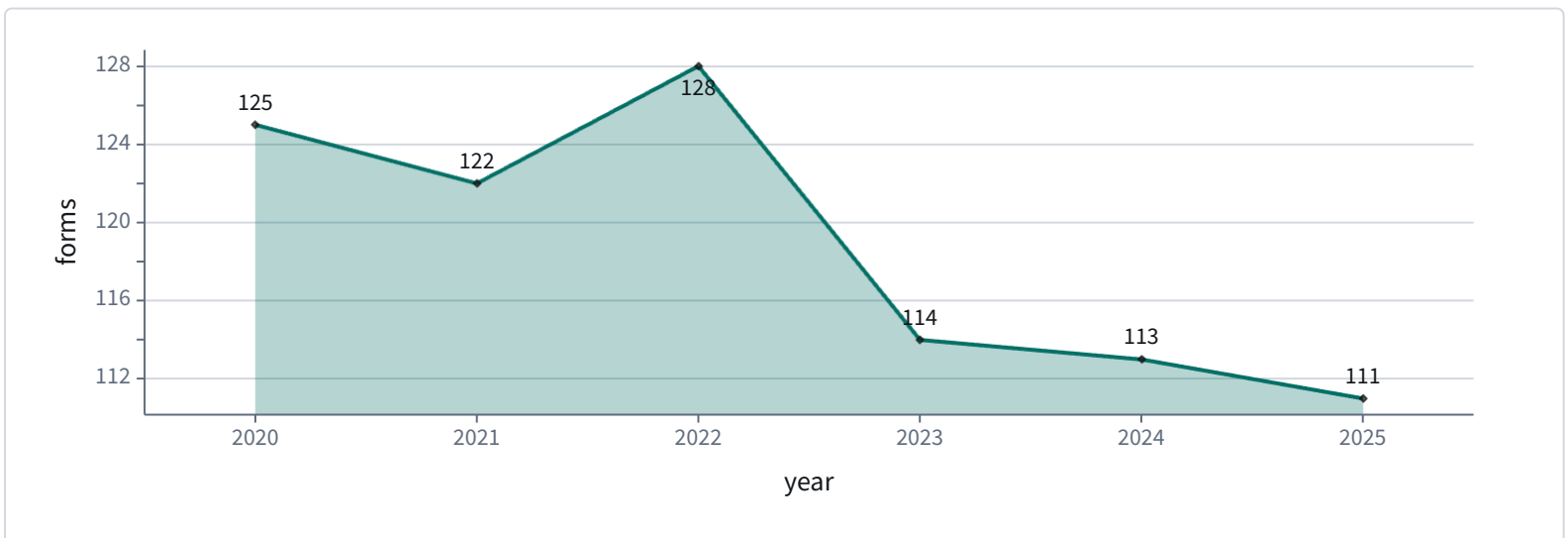

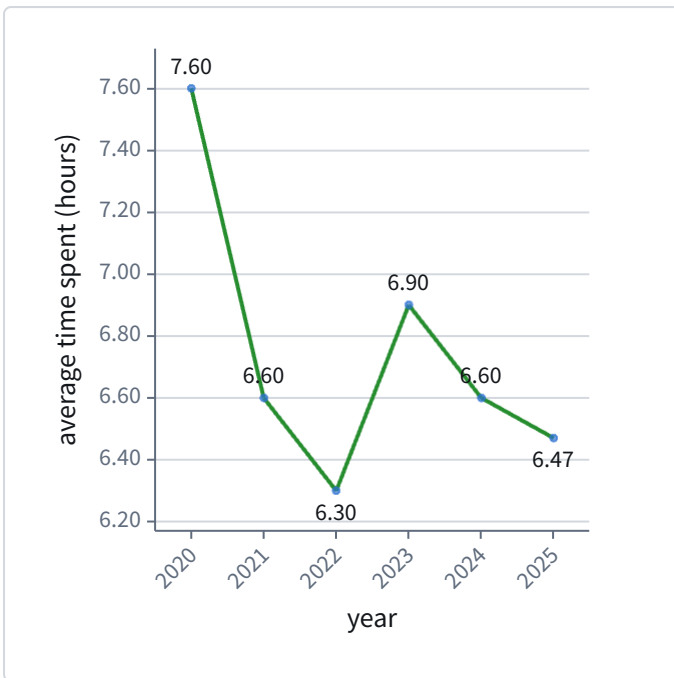

Average time spent by one respondent on completing statistical reports (hours)



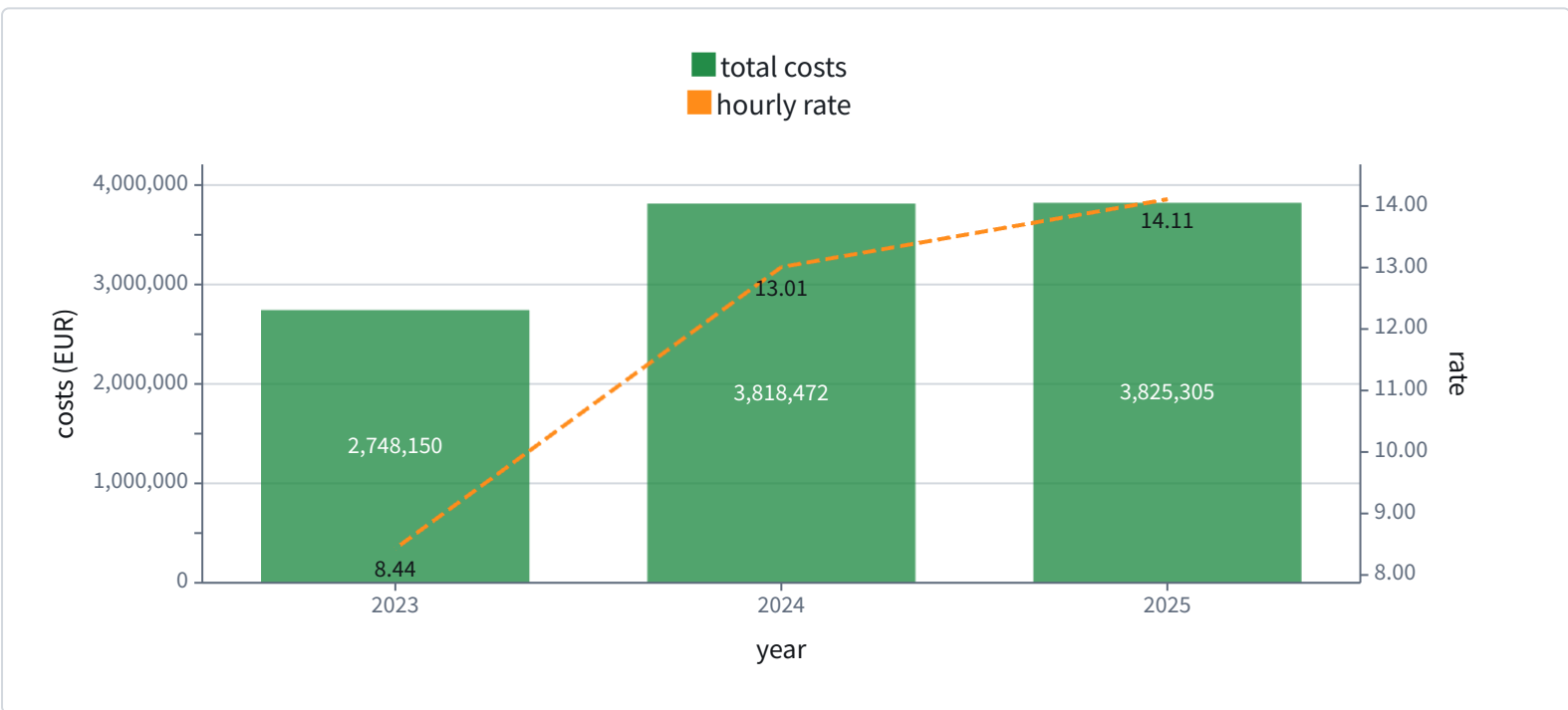

Respondents' financial costs for completing statistical reports (at current prices) in 2025

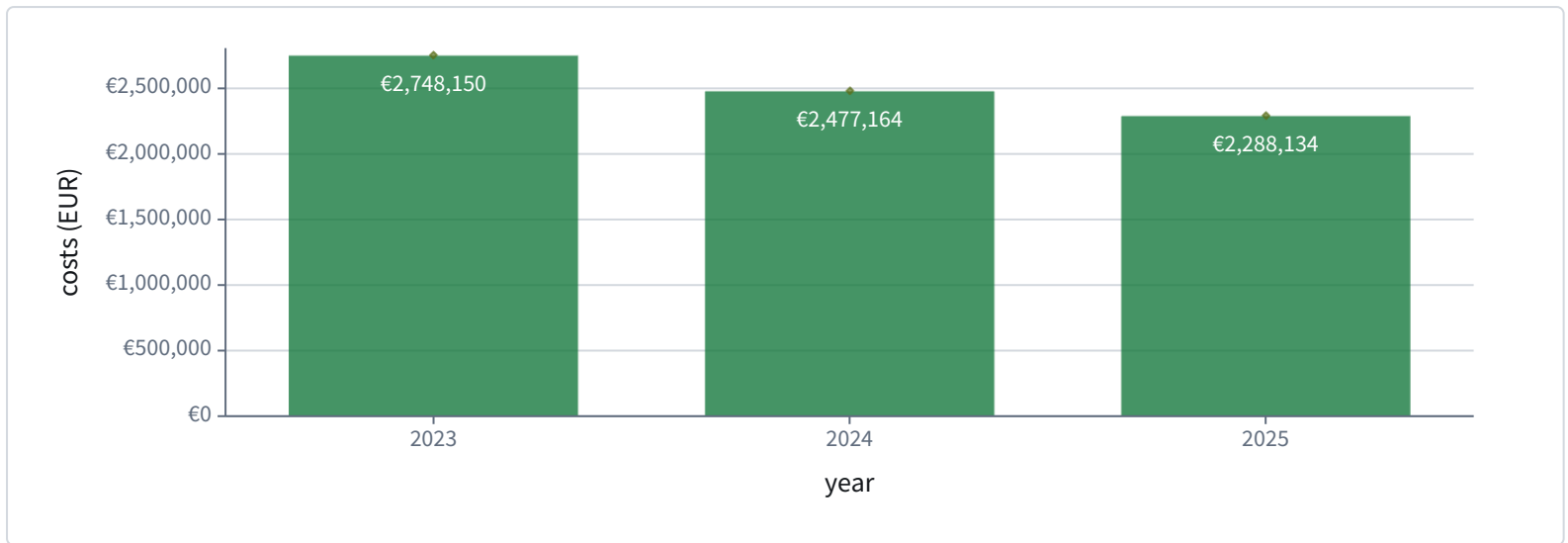
